## **Job summary**

LMHPs at Omaha Integrative Care are responsible for providing mental health treatments and related services integrated with patients' medical goals and needs. This may be done on an individual or group level and includes community education and awareness on the value of mind/body medicine and integrative care.

## **Summary of essential job functions**

- Coordinate all phases of care including initial assessment, care planning, monitoring, education and counseling of patients seeking mental health services.
- Evaluate, interpret, monitor and document the status and needs of patients using established standards of care and practice guidelines.
- Develop, review, update and implement educational materials to meet the needs of patients and professionals.
- Function as an integral member of the clinical interdisciplinary team.
- Collaborate and coordinate patient care with practitioners within and outside of Omaha Integrative Care.
- Market and promote to client base.
- Possess flexibility and empathy necessary to meeting patients' needs.
- Maintain continuing professional education specific including the areas of focus at Omaha Integrative Care, including but not limited to integrative healthcare and medicine.
- Attend regular interdisciplinary staff meetings and Omaha Integrative Care.
- Complete necessary administrative tasks related to billing and case management for patients.
- Assist in product sales and services as needed.
- Represent Omaha Integrative Care in the professional community.

## **Minimum requirements**

- Masters from an accredited counseling, social work, psychology or related program.
- Clinical experience and training.
- Licensed by the state of Nebraska.
- Commitment to an anti-oppressive therapeutic framework.
- Preference will be given to Licensed Independent Mental Health Providers.
- Preference given to individuals with training and experience working with youth under the age of 13.

- Preference given to individuals with training and experience working with LGBTQIA+ individuals.

- Communication skills relevant to working with patients and coordinating care with other medical providers.
