### Job Summary

- Past experience as a Psychiatric Nurse Practitioner for 1 year preferred.
- Must possess a valid license to practice as an Advanced Practice Nurse in the state of Nebraska.
- Must be credentialed as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner through the ANCC.
- Must be able to function independently while still contributing and collaborating to the integrative team.
- Preferred experience using Electronic Health Records (EHR). Athena is a plus.
- Must have an active DEA license.
- Basic computer skills, including Microsoft Office suite of products.
- Commitment to an anti-oppressive and inclusive practice.
